

#### More facts about Savonlinna

- Is located in the province of Eastern Finland and in the region of South Savo 207,000 visitors and 346,000 overnight
- stays (in the Savonlinna region) in 2021
- Olavinlinna Castle is the northernmost medieval castle in the world (built in 1475). Kerimäki Church is the world's biggest
- wooden church (constructed in 1847).
- Punkaharju is one of the oldest nature conservation areas in the world.
- There are two unique water national parks Linnansaari and Kolovesi in the region. Linnansaari is one of the oldest national parks Finland.
- Savonlinna Opera Festival in July is one of the most notable international events in the world and organized in the Olavinlinna Castle since 1912. Every year, it brings around 60,000 visitors to the castle to enjoy world-class quality opera.
  - There are over a hundred artistic birdhouses made by folk artist Marko Ruuskanen in the Savonlinna city centre.
