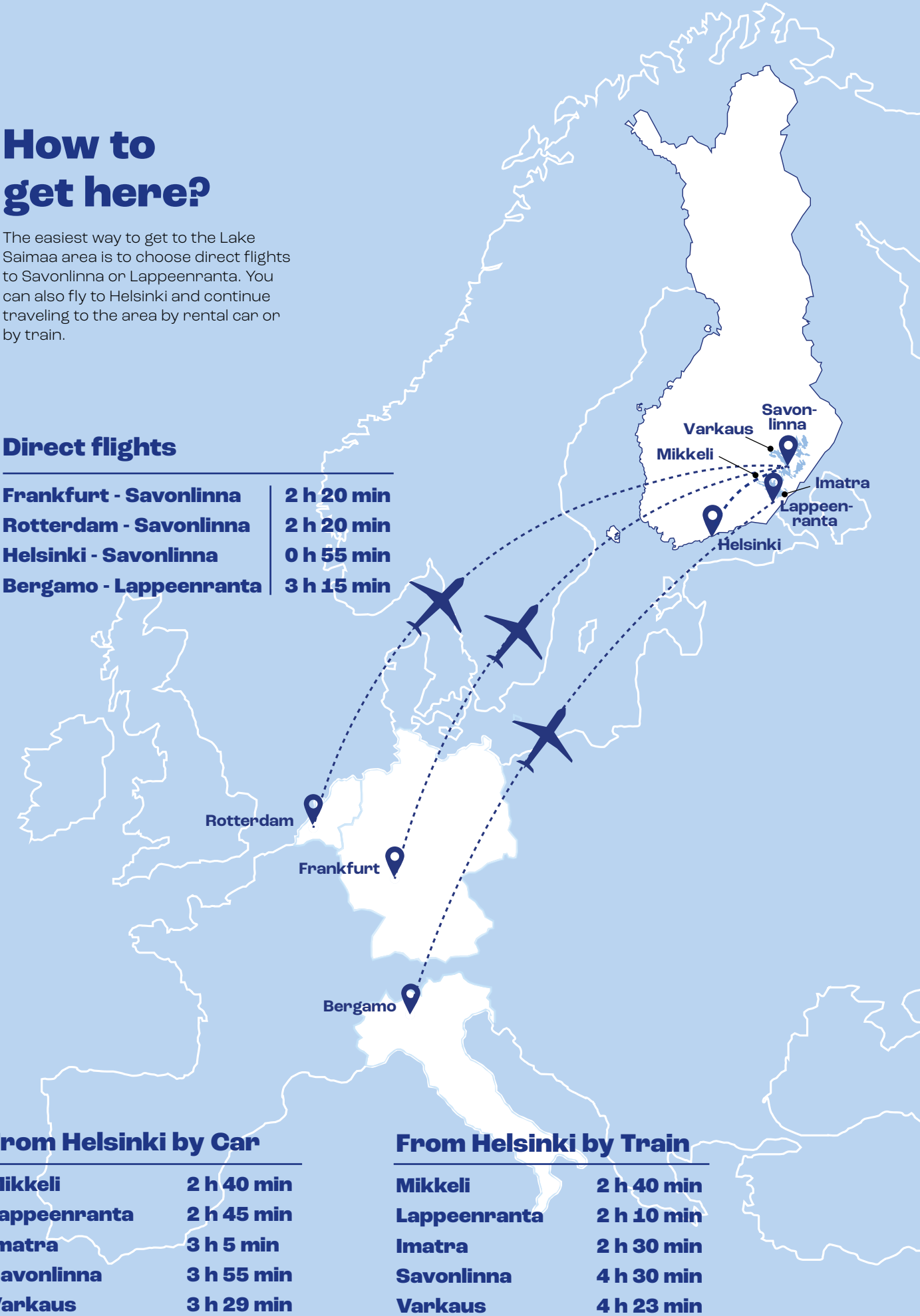

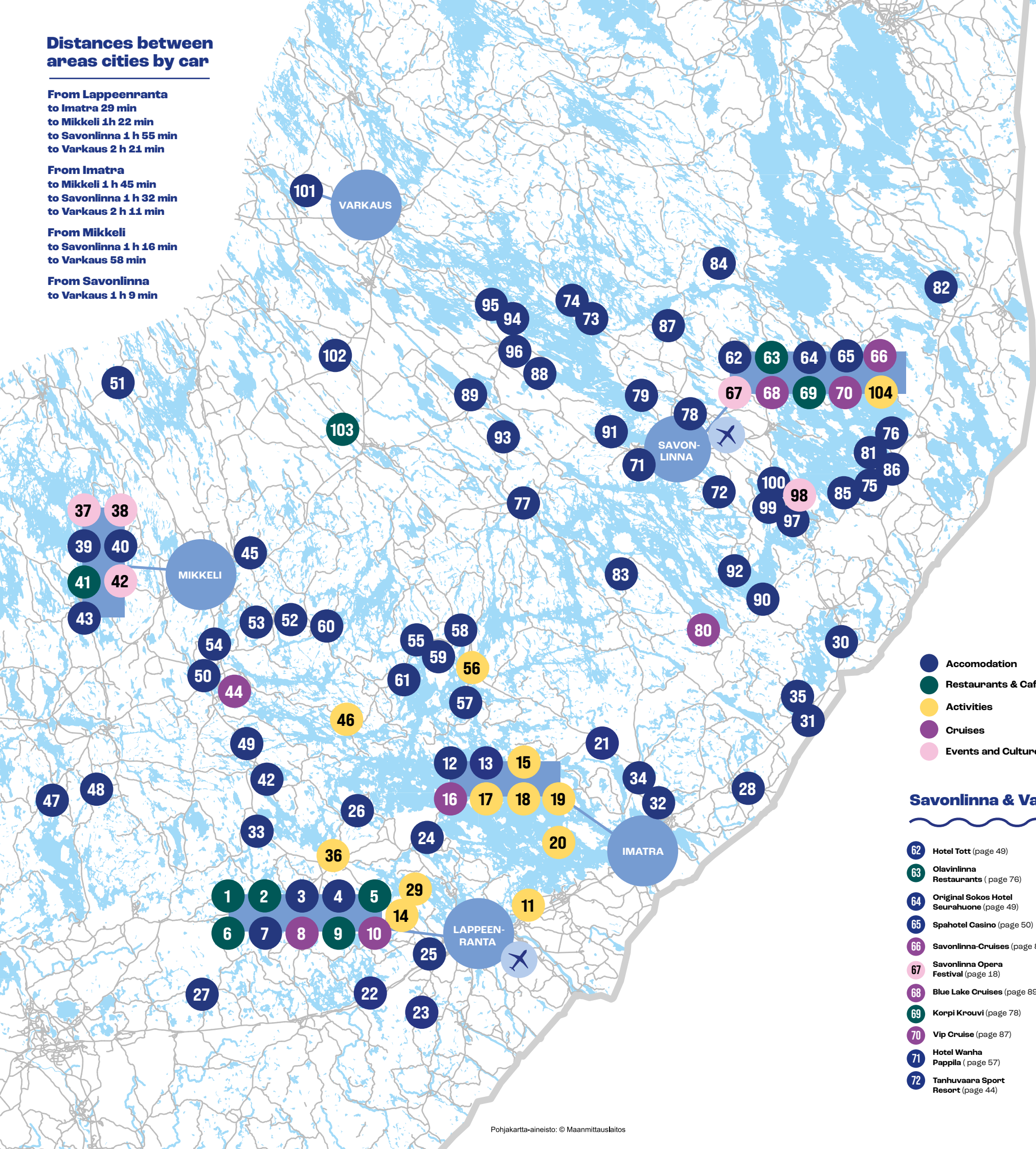

The Nature Paradise in Lakeland

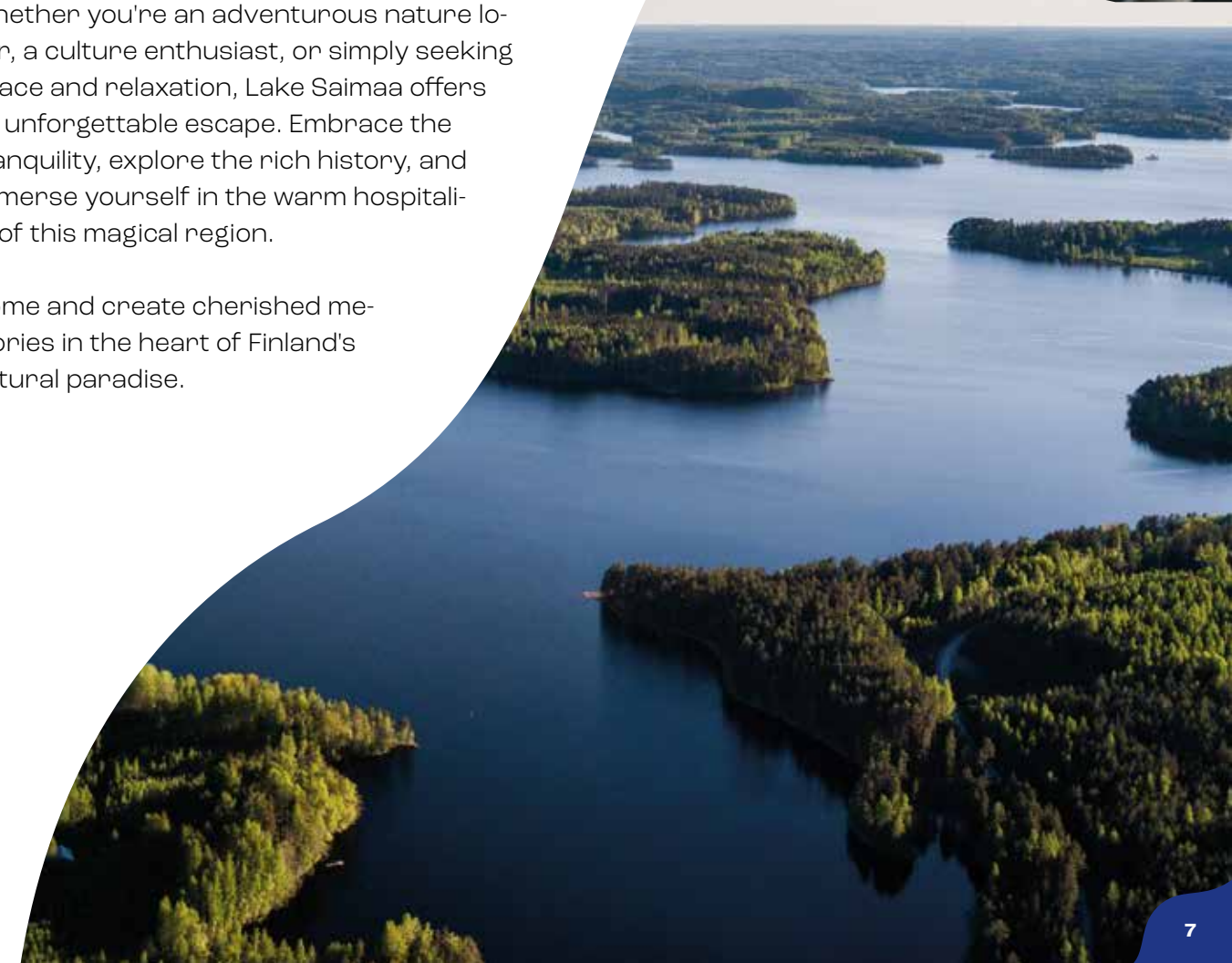

Lakeland – One of Finland's Four Main Regions

Finland is divided into four regions for international marketing: Lakeland, Lapland, the Coast and Archipelago and Helsinki Region. Lake Saimaa area is naturally part of the Lakeland Region. What separates Lake Saimaa from the other Lakeland areas? We have the largest lake in Europe, the largest fresh water archipelago in Finland and the space to enjoy it. You could say we are the happiest spot in a country of the happiest people. We even have our own seal the endangered "Saimaa norppa". There are five cities in the Lake Saimaa area and the regions around them have their own characteristics and specialities.

Lappeenranta – A Lively Harbor City

Lappeenranta is a vibrant university and harbor city located on the southern shore of Lake Saimaa. It is known for the historical Lappeenranta Fortress, which offers stunning views of the city and the lake. Karelian culture is strongly present here, and the city boasts excellent shopping opportunities, cultural events, and delicious local treats.

Imatra – The City of Rapids

Imatra is famous for the Imatrankoski rapids, one of Finland's oldest tourist attractions. The surrounding Crown Park Kruununpuisto and the The Scandic Imatran Valtionhotelli are the city's most well-known landmarks. The Vuoksi waterway offers various activities year-round, and the city boasts excellent outdoor and sports facilities.

Savonlinna – Home of the Opera Festival

Savonlinna is known for its 550 years old medieval Olavinlinna Castle, which hosts the annual Savonlinna Opera Festival. The city offers stunning scenery and boating opportunities. Nearby, you can find the world's largest wooden church in Kerimäki, the national landscape of Punkaharju ridge, and the canal village of Oravi with its various possibilities for outdoor experiences.

Varkaus – Heart of Industry

Varkaus is an industrial city known for its history in the wood industry and its beautiful lake scenery. The city features several museums and cultural sites, such as the Konsti Museum. Varkaus also boasts significant architecture by Alvar Aalto, like Kinkamon Aalto, which is open to the public with its general sauna shifts all year round.

Mikkeli – Cradle of History and Culture

Mikkeli is a bustling city on the north-west shore of Saimaa, known for historical sites. Mikkeli's diverse cultural heritage includes memories of military history. The Muisti Centre of War and Peace, the Headquarters Museum, and the Infantry Museum together form a unique ensemble. The city hosts various events, including the Mikkeli Music Festival. The Mikkeli region features beautiful manor houses, great local cuisine, and stunning natural sites like the Astuvansalmi rock paintings and the scenic Neitvuori hill.

No lake like Lake Saimaa

There are about 180,000 lakes in Finland, mostly small and shallow, formed by the last ice age, with an average depth of 7 meters. Saimaa is the largest, over 4,000 square kilometers, nearly 15,000 kilometers of shoreline, and over 17,000 islands. Saimaa's average depth is 17 meters, and it is home to the endangered Saimaa ringed seal, the only freshwater seal in the world.

Regional highlights



Olavinlinna

Olavinlinna Castle was founded in 1475 as a border fortress between Sweden and Russia (Novgorod). It is best known internationally as the venue for the annual Savonlinna Opera Festival. The castle attracts visitors from all over the world and invites them to explore its rich history and many stories. Olavinlinna Castle and its museum are open year-round, with guided tours organized daily.



Old Varkaus

Old Varkaus is a wonderful place to visit all year round. Magnificent architectural buildings and extensive cultural offerings for the whole family guarantee a pleasant visit on the shores of Lake Saimaa. In Varkaus you can also find buildings designed by well-known architects, such as Alvar Aalto.



Astuvansalmi Rock Paintings

Experience the ancient mysteries of Lake Saimaa by exploring the region's most famous rock paintings in Astuvansalmi. About 80 pictures are painted on the rock, from which you can distinguish people, moose and boats.



Manors

Visit wonderful manors, each with its own story to tell. These historic mansions charm their guests with their beautiful rooms, elegant architecture, lush gardens, delicious food and warm hospitality.



Kruunupuisto park

The beauty of Imatra is not limited to its history, but the city also boasts some stunning natural attractions. Kruunupuisto park, which is located in the grounds of the Scandic Imatran Valtionhotelli is a green oasis in the middle of the city.



Imatrankoski rapids

Imatra's history goes back centuries, and one of its most impressive landmarks is the Imatrankoski Rapids. Imatrankoski has served as a historical stage for several events. Beloved by tourists and artists, its captivating beauty has been immortalized in numerous artworks. Today, visitors can enjoy the rapids through seasonal rapid shows.



Lappeenranta Fortress

Lappeenranta Fortress, founded in 1649, offers more than just history. Museums, exhibitions, craft shops, cafés, restaurants, and year-round events attract visitors. The lush green ramparts are beloved by locals, serving as gathering spots for celebrations and leisure activities, such as sledding in winter and picnicking on May Day.



The Harbor of Lappeenranta

Lappeenranta's lively harbor hosts a variety of events and services throughout the year. From summer's vibrant music and markets to autumn's enchanting Harbor Lights event, and February's Winter Harbor activities on the icy lake, there's always something happening for visitors of all ages to enjoy.





From Saimaa to your plate – Explore the Gastronomic wonders

The Lake Saimaa region, with its pure waters and fertile soil, produces exceptionally high-quality food. The lakes teem with fish, and the forests offer a rich variety of herbs, mushrooms and berries depending on the season.

Organic food is an important part of the region's culinary offering. The region's markets and direct sales outlets are filled with fresh products in the summertime. Many farms and companies supplying local food are also great destinations to visit. The restaurants showcase their culinary expertise by preparing delicious dishes from ingredients sourced from local producers and farms.

1. Award-winning coffee from Lappeenranta

Lappeenranta has two award-winning coffee roasters, Lehmus Roastery and Makea Coffee, and can therefore be called the unofficial coffee capital of Finland. Enjoy Lehmus Roastery's coffee at their unique roastery in Lappeenranta Harbour, where the Satamatie 6 café is under the same roof. Makea Coffee serves its tasty coffees in the countryside at the lovely Pulsa Railway Station.

4. Lörtsy

Lörtsy is the pride of Savonlinna. A flat, half-moon-shaped pie made of puff pastry can be bought from market vendors and lunch cafés. It is at its best when enjoyed fresh. Lörtsy's filling can be salty or sweet. The pie can be filled with meat, fish or jam from apple or blueberries.



2. Särä - traditionally made mutton

Särä is South Karelia's pride, embodying Finland's oldest food tradition. Restaurant Säräpirtti Kippurasarvi in Lemi attracts visitors with its traditional särä dish, prepared according to an ancient recipe and cooked slowly in a wood-fired oven. Served with flatbread, home-brewed beer, and mixed fruit soup, särä's popularity lies in its authentic taste and story.

5. Vendace

Muikku (vendace) is a small fish that is a traditional delicacy and known especially in the Lake Saimaa region. It is a popular local dish often served fried and crispy. Muikku is a delicious and nutritious option worth trying when visiting the Lake Saimaa area.

Puruveden Muikku

Vendace from Puruvesi has a higher D-vitamin content than regular vendace because of the clear water of Lake Puruvesi. It has EU protected designation of origin (PDO) in 2013, ensuring its origin, ingredients, and production methods are recognized. This one is The Muikku in area.

3. Vety and Atomi

The authentic and original local delicacies sold at the Lappeenranta market square and harbour, such as Vety and Atomi. These delicacies are meat pies from a local bakery, filled with ham and egg as well as various spices. A perfect snack to enjoy with a cup of coffee or milk. The combination of these treats and the atmospheric surroundings offers travelers an unforgettable taste journey that will linger in their memory.

6. Food from nature and in nature

How about a wild food dinner on an island, mushroom picking in the forest, a seasonal harvest dinner, or getting to know the secrets of winter fishing and preparing the catch at the end of the trip? For those who love local food and the flavors of Lake Saimaa, Uhkua in Mikkeli offers culinary adventure tours.

Sustainable Travel Finland (STF) label:

The Path to Responsible Tourism



The Sustainable Travel Finland (STF) program, developed by Visit Finland, helps tourism companies and destinations adopt and maintain sustainable practices. Participants follow a structured 7-step process involving commitment, capacity building, certification, sustainability indicators, transparent communication, development planning, and regular verification. Achieving the STF label signifies a strong commitment to sustainability, offering travelers an easy way to identify responsible tourism providers. This program ensures continuous improvement and adherence to high sustainability standards, enhancing the overall quality and appeal of Finnish tourism. A company must already have an audited certification in place for the STF label to be approved.

How is STF visible in the Lake Saimaa area?

Companies participating in Visit Finland's STF program in the Lake Saimaa area demonstrate the region's commitment to sustainability. The more companies that join the STF path and achieve the label, the more the area's dedication to responsible tourism is highlighted. A region or city can apply for the STF label once more than half of

the designated area's internationalizing companies have received the label. In May 2023, the first STF label to destination in the Lake Saimaa area was awarded to Puumala, followed by the Savonlinna region in August 2023. The Savonlinna region has been awarded with the STF label as a first destination in Finland, which includes

several municipalities.

It is well known around the world that Finns are the happiest people on earth, and one significant reason for that is undoubtedly our surrounding nature. Finland is also known for having the cleanest air and water in the world. Here in Saimaa, you can visit wonderful natural gems, including national parks, national landscapes, and Geopark sites.

National landscapes

There are 27 official national landscapes in Finland and 4 of them are in our region. Olavinlinna and Pihlajavesi, Punkaharju, Imatrankoski and Heinävesi route. National landscapes are part of Finnish history and tell great story about Finnishness.



National Parks

Overall, Finland has 41 National Parks, including the unique water National Parks of Linnansaari and Kolovesi in Savonlinna region, and Repovesi on a border of Kouvola and Mäntyharju.

Linnansaari

Linnansaari's main island offers camping, cabin accommodation, a sauna, a summer café, a grill shelter, and hiking trails. Travelers can reach the island via guided tours, water taxi, or by paddling. It's an excellent spot to observe the Saimaa ringed seal, ospreys, and other wildlife like beavers, otters, moose, and badgers.

Kolovesi

Kolovesi is an independent paddler's paradise, as it's the only way to explore the national park. Its rocky cliffs, adorned with historic rock paintings, offer a mesmerizing

experience, connecting you with ancient times. Kolovesi is accessible only in the summer. Guided tours available.

Repovesi

Repovesi National Park in Kouvola and Mäntyharju features towering cliffs, majestic forests, and clear blue waters. The park offers year-round activities. With 45 kilometers of marked trails, including the 26-kilometer Kaakkuri Trail, Repovesi is accessible to visitors with mobility challenges and has many rest stops and docks for a comfortable adventure.

Saimaa Geopark

The Saimaa UNESCO Global Geopark brings together nature attractions, such as ridge terrains, the most amazing sandy beaches, rock formations and paintings, fortresses, hill forts and other historically significant

sites of Saimaa. Discover these natural formations by hiking, cycling, by boat or canoe. Through these destinations and landscapes, the story of Saimaa's formation as told by the Saimaa Geopark unfolds in a whole new way.

Saimaa Ringed Seal

The Saimaa ringed seal (*Pusa hispida saimensis*), in Finnish saimaannonppa or just norppa is one of the most endangered and rarest seals in the world and it can only be found in Lake Saimaa.

When the Ice Age ended more than 8,000 years ago, our Saimaa ringed seal was isolated from the other seals and adapted to our waters and its brains and eyes evolved larger than its close relatives. The fur pattern of the Saimaa ringed seal differs from others and each norppa has its own unique ring-like pattern, which is a bit like a fingerprint. Each norppa can be identified as its own individual and the most famous of them get a name like Sulo, Pullervo or Viljo, other individuals get their own identification number. About 430 individuals live in Saimaa, each of which we are trying to identify and get to know their habits.

May is the best month to spot a Saimaa ringed seal

In May, Saimaa ringed seal moults and then it likes to lie on the rocks and islets to dry its fur. This is the best time for Saimaa ringed seal safaris. This is also a time when you should not disturb a seal when it is laying on the rocks. Guided trips are made from safe distance and our companies have made a pledge that they make only seal-friendly excursions.

After the moulting season, the seals go back into the water. In July, the head of a Saimaa ringed

seal that occasionally peaks from the water is evidence that this mystical creature exists. At this season the best chance to spot Saimaa ringed seals is with guides who know waters well. The lake nature and life of norppa are discovered on these kayaking/canoeing trips or cruises in a whole new way.

The Savonian and Karelian cultures are evident in different cities

in their own unique ways, offering a hospitable, chatty, and authentic culture with long traditions. The region's museums, such as the Finnish Forest Museum Lusto, shed light on the Finnish forest culture and its importance, while the War and Peace Center Muisti explores the impact of war on the region in the past and future. In Varkaus, you can experience how an entire city has been built around the forest industry, which still functions as part of everyday life, strongly hand in hand with history.

The new museum center Konsti tells the story of its birth, after which the city itself opens up with completely new way. Each city's own story is strongly built around one element: Lake Saimaa. We live, breathe, experience, and cherish nature, culture and traditions.

As a result, smoke saunas are a disappearing folk tradition, experienced by fewer and fewer people. If you have the opportunity to enjoy a smoke sauna, don't miss it.

Finns are constantly seeking and inventing new ways to enjoy saunas. You might come across a tent sauna, an ice sauna, a sauna in a car, a sauna on a trailer, a barrel sauna, train sauna or even a sauna in a playhouse. For Finns, only imagination is the limit when it comes to saunas.
